| Facts found: <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. During first beat of race 8 wind speed was around 8 knots with fairly choppy waves. 2. GBR and FRA beating on starboard at a speed between 6 and 7 knots, with GBR between 3 and 5 boat lengths astern on a course between one and two boat lengths to windward of the course of FRA. 3. FRA tacked to port, lost speed and was on a collision course with GBR. 4. When GBR was one boat length away from FRA, the bow of GBR pointed at the aft third of FRA. GBR bore away and passed half a meter behind FRA. | |
| Conclusion: GBR, on starboard, bore away to avoid collision with FRA on port. FRA failed to keep clear of GBR as required by rule 10. (WS Case 50) | |
